Subject: Facility for selecting of Examination State/City/Date/Shift in CUET (UG) 2026-reg.

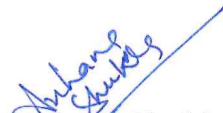
The National Testing Agency is conducting the **Common University Entrance Test (CUET-UG) – 2026** at various examination centres located in different cities across the country and abroad. The examination will be held from **11 May 2026 to 31 May 2026** in **Computer Based Test (CBT)** mode.

2. The Exam Centre City and Examination Schedule have already been communicated to all eligible candidates through the **Advance Exam City Intimation Slip**, which was issued on **29 April 2026**.

3. Candidates who have been allotted an examination city other than the preferences submitted by them in their online application form are hereby informed that they may opt for a **change of examination State, City, Date, and/or Shift**, as per the availability of slots of their opted subject combination. This facility will be available from **05 May 2026 to 07 May 2026 (up to 11:50 PM)**.

4. In view of the limited available slots, the seats will be allocated dynamically (First come first serve basis). Candidates who avail this facility will be issued a **Revised Admit Card** in due course. Candidates who do not exercise this option within the stipulated period shall be required to appear for the examination as per the **already allotted examination State, City, Date, and Shift**.
